1. **Apologies:** Clare Holmes
2. **Minutes of Last Meeting:** Were Accepted
3. **Matters Arising:** None
4. **Chairman's Report:** The 1st Beginners course has finished, we start the next one 12th November and we have another on the 7th January.
5. **Treasurer's Report:** Membership all paid, some people from beginner's course have joined. To hire Ysgol Ruabon Sport Hall it costs £56 for the 2 hours and we are not having enough members using it (Secretary will send another email to members).
