1: Club Codes of Conduct

1:1 Overview

It is the policy of Croesoswallt Archers that all archers, volunteers, coaches, and parents show respect and understanding for each other and conduct themselves in a way that reflects the principles of the Club. The aim is for archers to improve their performance and have fun.

Everyone involved in the club should abide by the Club rules and policies.

1:2 Conduct of archers / members

Archers / Members should:

- Take care of all property belonging to the Club or other club members
- Treat other club members with respect at all times on and off the shooting range
- Control tempers and avoid behaviour and bad language which may inconvenience or offend others
- Co-operate and listen to coaches and club officials

1:3 Conduct of Officials, Coaches and Volunteers

Club officials, coaches and volunteers should

- Consider the wellbeing and safety of all archers before the development of performance
- Make sure that all activities are appropriate to the age, ability, and experience of those taking part in archery
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance
- Follow Archery GB and Club guidelines and policies
- Hold appropriate and up to date qualifications and insurance
- Encourage archers to value performance and not just results
- Never condone the use of prohibited substances

1:4 Conduct of Parents or Guardians

Parents/ Guardians should:

- Never force your child to take part in sport
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept official's judgements
- Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy the sport
- Set a good example by applauding good performance of all archers.
